### ***General Business***

### ***Fundraising***

Brookhill Swim Club has offered to donate a 1-year family membership for the troop to auction (\$500 minimum bid). All proceeds to go to the troop. Jack will send out an announcement. The auction will be open to Cub Scout troop families as well.

### ***Troop Leadership – Jay***

The next SPL will be Noah Monetti. The change will be formally announced at the next court of honor. This will take place at the picnic.

### ***Sabattis Trek Planning***

Only eight people have signed up for the trek, and only three have paid. We must choose either the 11-man trek or the 7-man trek. Our pricing is based on the 11-man trek. We agreed that discounts may be offered to fill the 11-man roster. As a last resort, if the leaders are unable to fill the 11-man roster by the deadline, they may switch to the 7-man trek, by dropping the last (8<sup>th</sup>) person who signed up. The decision is to be based on minimizing the cost to the troop

account. The troop will pay up to the price differential between the two treks, plus up to \$150 total for gas.

17 hours of community service was reported for troop participation in the town Memorial Day ceremony.

### **PPC Wilderness First Aid (WFA) and CPR Training**

Patriot's Path Council has developed an affordable WFA course (2-days long, Saturday and Sunday), and published the schedule for 2012 and 2013. They have also made CPR training (prerequisite for WFA) available on a coordinated schedule (Friday evenings, 4.5 hours). This has been geared toward Philmont crews via the Watchu program, but it is available to all (14 or older).
